

Information and communication technologies for development

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 56/183 of 21 December 2001, 57/238 of 20 December 2002, 57/270 B of 23 June 2003, 59/220 of 22 December 2004 and 60/252 of 27 March 2006,

Recalling also the Declaration of Principles and the Plan of Action adopted by the World Summit on the Information Society at its first phase, held at Geneva from 10 to 12 December 2003, 1 as endorsed by the General Assembly, 2 and the Tunis Commitment and the Tunis Agenda for the Information Society adopted by the Summit at its second phase, held at Tunis from 16 to 18 November 2005, 3 and endorsed by the General Assembly, 4

Recalling further the 2005 World Summit Outcome,5

- 1. *Reaffirms* the strong development orientation of the outcomes of both the Geneva and the Tunis phases of the Summit, and urges their full implementation;
- 2. *Reaffirms also* its request to the Economic and Social Council to oversee the system-wide follow-up of the Geneva and Tunis outcomes of the Summit;
- 3. *Requests* the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly, through the Economic and Social Council, a report on the status of implementation of the Summit outcomes, including recommendations on the follow-up process, for consideration by the Council at its substantive session of 2008.
