### **Integrated and coordinated implementation of and follow-up to the outcomes of the major United Nations conferences and summits in the economic, social and related fields**

*The General Assembly,*

*Recalling* its resolutions 57/144 of 16 December 2002 and 57/270 B of 23 June 2003,

1. *Decides* to convene in 2005 a United Nations summit on development, on dates to be decided by the General Assembly at its fifty-ninth session;

2. *Stresses* that the summit will be an opportunity to undertake a comprehensive review of the implementation of all the outcomes and commitments of the major United Nations conferences and summits and to assess the progress made in international cooperation for development towards the achievement of the internationally agreed development goals, including those contained in the United Nations Millennium Declaration;<sup>1</sup>

3. *Decides* to entrust the President of the fifty-eighth session of the General Assembly to start as soon as possible consultations regarding the preparatory process to ensure the success of the summit.
