Role of the United Nations in promoting development in the context of globalization and interdependence

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolutions 53/169 of 15 December 1998, 54/231 of 22 December 1999 and 55/212 of 20 December 2000 on the role of the United Nations in promoting development in the context of globalization and interdependence,

1. *Takes note* of the report of the Secretary-General on the role of the United Nations in promoting development in the context of globalization and interdependence;¹
2. *Takes note also* of the deliberations of the Preparatory Committee for the International Conference on Financing for Development, to be held in Monterrey, Mexico, from 18 to 22 March 2002;
3. *Welcomes* the engagement of all relevant stakeholders in the preparatory process of the International Conference on Financing for Development;
4. *Requests* the Secretary-General to report to the General Assembly at its fifty-seventh session on the outcome of the Conference, with particular emphasis on its impact on the role of the United Nations in promoting development in the context of globalization and interdependence;
5. *Decides* to include in the provisional agenda of its fifty-seventh session the item entitled "Role of the United Nations in promoting development in the context of globalization and interdependence".
