## Restrictive business practices

## The General Assembly,

**Recalling** its resolution **J5/63** of 5 December 1980, by which it adopted the Set of Multilaterally Agreed Equitable Principles and Rules for the Control of Restrictive **Buriness** Practices, and decided to convene, in 1985, under the auspices of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, a United Nations conference to review all aspects of the Set of Principles and Rules,

Having considered the report of the United Nations Conference to Review All Aspects of the Set of Multilaterally Agreed Equitable Principles and Rules for the Control of Restrictive Business Practices, together with the proposals made by regional groups, 1/ and the outcome of the consultations held in pursuance of its resolution 40/192 of 17 December 1985, contained in the report of the Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, 2/
