## Commodities

The Genera 1 Assembly,

Recalling its recolutione 3201 (S-VI) and 3202 (S-VI) of 1 May 1974. containing the Declaration and the Programme of Action on the Establishment of a New International Economic Order, 3281 (XXIX) of 12 December 1974, containing the Charter of Economic Rights and Duties of States, 3362 (S-VII) of 16 September 1975 on development and international economic co-operation, and 35/56 of 5 December 1980, the annex to which contains the International Development Strategy for the Third United Nation8 Development Decade,

Recalling also United Nations Conference on Trade and Development resolutions 93 (IV) of 30 May 1976, 1/124 (V) of 3 June 1979 2/ and 155 (VI) of 2 July 1983 3/

on the Integrated Programme for Commodities and 153 (VI) of 2 July 1993 3/ on the Common Fund for Commodities.

Expressing deep concern at the prevent state of world trade in commodities,

Bearing in mind Trade and Development Board decision 341 (XXXIII) of 3 October 1986 4/on the provisional agenda, place, date and duration of the seventh session of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development,

- 1. Stresses the urgent need for appropriate and early action to addreou the deteriorating situation of developing countries in the field of commodities;
- 2. <u>Urges</u> all **Statee to make the** maximum **efforts** to contribute to the achievement of positive results, including the adoption of concrete and action-oriented **measures at the seventh session** of the United **Nations** Conference on Trade and Development, in **the** solution of commodity probleme, particularly those adversely affecting the economies of developing countries, and to the full implementation of the Integrated Programme for **Commodities**;
- 3. Requests the Secretary-General of the United Nationo Conference on Trade and Development to continue to monitor closely movements in international commodity trade, including long-term trends and prospects for primary commodities, in accordance with the mandate of the Conference8
- 4. <u>Decides</u> to review at its forty-second session the relevant outcome of the aeventh session of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development and to give imptus to follow-up action in the field of commodities.
