Yugoslav la ** revised draft resolution

Proclamation of the World Decade for Cultural Development

The General Assembly,

Considering recommendation No. 27 1/ adopted by the World Conference on Cultural Policies organized by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization at Mexico City in 1982, in which it recommended that the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization propose to the General Assembly of the United Nations the proclamation of a world decade for cultural development,

Considering also resolution 11.20 and 11.10 adopted by the General Conference of the United Notions Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization at its twenty-second and twenty-third sessions, respectively,

Recalling Economic and Social Council resolution 1986/69 of 23 July 1986, in which the Council recommended that the General Assembly take a decision at its forty-first session on the question of the proclamation of a world decade for cultural development,

Taking Into account the interest that the international community, Including the organizations of the United Nations system, have shown in the proposed decade,

Recognizing that the voluntary efforts at the national level by interested individuals and non-governmental and governmental organizations, are one of the principal vehicles for advancing the objectives of the decade,

<u>Taking note</u> of the draft plan of action for the world decade for cultural development, eubmitted by the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, 2/

- 1. <u>Proclaims</u> the period **1988-1997** the World Decade for Cultural Development, to be observed under the auspices of the United Nations, with the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization acting as the lead agency;
- 2. Approves the four main objectives of the Decade: acknowledging the cultural dimension of development; affirming and enriching cultural identities; breadening participation in culture ard promoting international cultural co-operation;
- 3. <u>Invites</u> all States, intergovernmental **and** international non-governmental **organizations**, and interested individuals to take an active part in the fulfilment of the **objectives** of the Decade and, for that purpose, to make available, on a voluntary **basis**, taking into consideration their **particula** situation, prior ities and **means**, the necessary intellectual, human and financial **resources**;
- 4. <u>Encourages</u> organizations, organs and bodies of the United Nation8 eyetem participating in the fulfilment of the objectives of the Decade to do so in a manner which does not entail additional financial implications for non-voluntary unded programmee from their respective regular budgets;
- 5. Requests the Secretary-General, with respect to established programme priorities, to ensure through the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination that activities undertaken by the Jnited Nations eyetem in eupport of the Decade are co-ordinated in such a manner as to avoid duplication and overlap;
- 6. Requests the Secretary-General of the United Nations and the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization to report biennially to the General Assembly, through the Economic and Social Council at its second regular session, on the progress of the World Decade for Cultural Development.
