Proclamation of the World Decade for Cultural Development

The General Assembly,

<u>Considering</u> recommendation No. 27 1/ adopted by the World Conference on Cultural Policies convened by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization at Mexico City in 1982, in which it recommended that the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization propose to the General Assembly of the United Nations the proclamation of a world decade for cultural development,

<u>Considering also</u> resolution 11.20 $\frac{2}{}$ and 11.10 $\frac{3}{}$ adopted by the General Conference of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization at its twenty-second and twenty-third sessions, respectively,

Recalling Economic and Social Council resolution 1986/69 of 23 July 1986, in which the Council recommended that the General Asserbly take a decision at its

forty-first session on the question of the proclamation of a world **decade** for cultural development,

Taking into account the interest that the international community, including the **organizations** of the United Nations **system**, have shown in the proposed **decade**,

<u>Recognizing</u> that voluntary efforts at the national level by interested individuals and non-qovernmental and **governmental** organizations are a principal means of advancing the objectives of the decade,

<u>Taking note</u> of the draft plan of action for the world decade for cultural **development**, submitted by the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, 4/

1. <u>Proclaim8</u> the Period 1988-1997 the World Decade for Cultural Development, to be observed under the auspices of the United Nations and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization;

2. <u>Approves</u> the four main objective8 of the **Decade:** acknowledging the cultural dimension of **development; affirming** and enriching cultural identities; broadening participation in cultures and promoting international cultural co-operationr

3. <u>Invites</u> all States, **intergovernmental** and **international** non-governmental organizations, and interested individuals to take an active part in the **fulfilment** of the objectives of the Decade and, for **that purpose**, to make available, on a voluntary basis and taking into consideration their particular **situation**, **priorities** and means, the necessary intellectual, human and financial **resources**;

4. <u>Encourages</u> the organizations, organe and bodies of the United Nations system participating in the fulfilment of the objectives of **the** Decade to do **so** in a **manner** which is in accordance with established programme **priorities** and which does not entail additional financial implications for non-voluntarily funded programmesr

5. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to ensure, through the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination, that **activities** undertaken by the United Nations **system** in support of the Decade are co-ordinated in such a manner **as** to avoid duplication and **overlap**;

6. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General of the United Nations and the Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization to report biennially to the General Assembly, through the Economic and Social Council at its second regular session, on the Qrogreos of the World Decade for Cultural Development.
