SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC COOPERATION: HUMAN SETTLEMENTS

Philippines*: draft resolution

Commission on Human Settlements

The General Assembly,

Recalling its resolution 32/162 of 19 December 1977, in which the Assembly established the Commission on Human Settlements and its secretariat, the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements (Habitat), to serve as the institutional focus for human settlements activities within the United Nations system,

Recalling also its resolution 43/181 of 20 December 1988, in which it designated the Commission on Human Settlements as the intergovernmental body responsible for coordination, evaluating and monitoring the implementation of the Global Strategy for Shelter to the Year 2000, $\underline{1}$ /

Recalling further resolution 47/180 of December 1992, in which it decided to convene the Second United Nations Conference on Human Settlements (Habitat II) from 3 to 14 June 1996, and to establish an ad hoc secretariat for the Conference that would be an organizational part of the Centre,

Noting with satisfaction the positive role played by the Centre in the implementation of the Strategy and the human settlement aspects of Agenda 21, $\underline{2}$ /

Noting with concern that two thirds of the entire increase in world population currently occurs in urban areas, so that by the year 2000 almost 50 per cent of the world population will be living in towns and cities, and that that trend is straining the capacity of Governments, at both the national and local levels, to mobilize the financial, technical and managerial resources necessary to sustain such human settlements,

- 1. <u>Endorses</u> the report of the Commission on Human Settlements on the work of its fifteenth session (Nairobi, 25 April-1 May 1995), 3/ including its decision 15/1 on the implementation of the Global Strategy for Shelter to the Year 2000; 1/
- 2. Takes note with appreciation of the contribution of the Commission and of the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements (Habitat) to the preparations at the national, regional and global levels for the Second United Nations Conference on Human Settlements (Habitat II), to be held in Istanbul from 3 to 14 June 1996;
- 3. <u>Encourages</u> the Commission and the Centre to submit their contributions to the preparations for the Conference to the Preparatory Committee at its third session, to be held in New York from 26 February to 8 March 1996;
- 4. <u>Invites</u> the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly at its fifty-second session a report on the role of the Commission in the implementation and follow-up of the decisions and recommendations of the Conference.
